SHOW RULES & IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **It is important to OPFHA that everyone in our shows has the best experience possible. If you have any needs which we could address in advance to make your experience better, please contact Alei Ortiz at 352-427-0242. If you have any ADA accessibility issues, you can reach the show facility at 352-750-5500. Please include with entry if you have any mobility issues requiring parking close to stalls or arena.**
- **Inspections: All riders placed first, second and third must step into check out area upon exiting the main arena, where they will be asked to drop the horses bit for inspection by the Show Steward.**
- **ALL fees must be paid & paperwork completed before exhibitor back numbers are released.**
- **4% credit card processing fee added to all credit card transactions.**
- **ALL horses will be charged a stall fee. NO grounds fees available**
- **50% refund will be issued for class entry fees with vet certificate after 08/26/22. Horses that submit a certificate in order to receive a refund will not be allowed to show in this event.**
- **\$100.00 handling fee will be charged for all returned checks/declined credit cards.**
- **CLOSE OUT: Failure to close out show bill will incur an added \$50.00 to your show bill.**
- **If show bill is not paid in full , returned check or declined credit card is not paid in full within 2 weeks after notification, PFHA will be immediately notified of the non-compliance!**

- **Parking:** Horse trailer parking is NOT permitted in barn area. Horse trailers MUST be parked in designated trailer parking areas.

PLEASE READ ALL FEES ASSOCIATED TO SHOW!

- **ALL exhibitors must enter the arena when called by gatekeeper. It is your responsibility to be in warm up arena 30 minutes before your class! Barn calls are a courtesy!**

- **Show Management reserves the right to combine classes if less than 3 entries in a class.**

SHOW MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRIES.

- **Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges, officials or show staff, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee, other fees and may be asked to leave showgrounds.**

- **Dogs must be on a leash on showgrounds.**

FOOTING

Sand & Clay in show arena

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense.

Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

- Head South on Hwy 441/27. Go past The Villages Regional Hospital.
- Go past the overhead bridge that says “The Villages.”
- Turn left onto Griffin Avenue (*Shell gas station on corner*).
- Stay on Griffin Ave. until you reach the stoplight. Turn left at light onto CR 25.
- Turn right at Marion County Road (*Grand Oaks electronic sign is on the corner*).
- Stay on Marion County Rd. for about a mile and turn right at the second gated entrance.
