ALL Entries must include the following paperwork in order to receive pre-entry pricing:

- Completed Entry Form
- Signatures Required
- All signed documents and Releases
 - PFHA Membership Number
 - All exhibitors, owners and trainers must have their Safe Sport up to date 30-day health certificate including instate horses
 - 12-month negative Coggins record
- Vaccination Record showing EHV1 and EHV4 - Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering show.

Form of Payment- Emailed entries must include credit card payment using credit card authorization form.

4% credit card processing fee will be added to all credit card transactions.

(Check can be submitted at check in for payment in place of credit card, but entry must include completed credit card form)

SHOW RULES & IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **Before a judge shares their remarks, the PFHA would like to remind everyone that judge's comments are provided for educational purposes only. These comments reflect the judge's personal observations of a horse and rider's individual performance at a specific moment in time. They are not intended to determine a horse's value, assess the quality of its breeding, or predict future performance. Rather, they are simply the judge's impressions based on what was seen at the show. Thank you for your understanding.**
- **Ocala PFHA has an official Whats App group chat named "Ocala PFHA Events 2025" used for all important show updates and announcements. This chat is one of several ways we communicate important information, along with the live announcements during the show, social media posts, and printed notices posted throughout the showgrounds. Please make sure to pay attention to the messages posted there so you can stay informed and up to date. If you are not currently included in the chat, please contact Luis Gonzalez at 407-242-0081 so he can add your number to the group.**
- **It is important to PFHA that everyone in our shows has the best experience possible. with entry if you have any mobility issues requiring parking close to stalls or arena.

- **ALL fees must be paid & paperwork completed before exhibitor back numbers are released.**
- **4% credit card processing fee added to all credit card transactions.**
- **ALL horses will be charged a non-refundable stall fee. NO ground fees available**
- **50% refund will be issued for class entry fees with vet certificate after 2/2/26. Horses that submit a certificate to receive a refund will not be allowed to show in this event.**
- **\$100.00 handling fee will be charged for all returned checks/declined credit cards.**
- **CLOSE OUT: Failure to close out show bill on the last show day, Sunday, 2/8/26 will incur an added \$50.00 to your show bill.**
- **If show bill is not paid in full, returned check or declined credit card is not paid in full within 2 weeks after notification, PFHA will be immediately notified of the non-compliance!**

PLEASE READ ALL FEES ASSOCIATED TO SHOW!

- **ALL exhibitors must enter the arena when called by gatekeeper. It is your responsibility to be in warm up arena 30 minutes before your class! Barn calls are a courtesy!**
- **ALL arenas will close one hour after the show ends and 2:00 am curfew for all parties and loud music at barns! Horses need to rest! Be considerate of Horses and neighbors!**
- **Show Management reserves the right to combine classes if less than 3 entries in a class.**

- **SHOW MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRIES.**

- **Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges, officials or show staff, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee, other fees and may be asked to leave showgrounds.**

- **Dogs must be on a leash on showgrounds.**

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

AWARDS:

**Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st-6th place in class.
Championship Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st – 4th place in the
Championship Class.**



DIRECTIONS:

From I-75 (North or South):

Take **exit 354** for **US-27/US-301/US-441**

Toward **Ocala**

Continue **east** on **US-27/301/441** for approximately **3 miles**

Turn **left** onto **NE 25th Avenue**

Continue straight for about **1 mile**

Turn **right** onto **NE Jacksonville Road (CR 200A)**

The **Southeastern Livestock Pavilion** will be on your **left**

From Downtown Ocala:

Head **north** on **NE Pine Avenue (US-301/441)**

Turn **right** onto **NE 20th Street**

Turn **left** onto **NE Jacksonville Road (CR 200A)**

Continue for about **0.5 miles**; the Pavilion will be on your **right**

From SR-40 (Silver Springs Boulevard):

Travel to **NE 36th Avenue** and turn **north**

Follow **NE 36th Avenue** to **NE Jacksonville Road** and turn **left**

Continue **south**; the Pavilion will be on your **right**
